* ء hamzah is omitted at the beginning of a word; elsewhere, it is written, eg., أَحْمَد Ahmad, but مُؤَسَّةٌ muassasah, دَائِمٌ dāim, خَطِيفٌ khatīf.

** The preposition لـ in combination with following article الـ is written *lil-*, e.g., *lil-kitāb*, *lil-shams*. Note that the لـ of the article is not assimilated to the “sun”-letters, e.g., *al-safir*.

*** ةـ is romanized *at* in a word in the construct state. To distinguish romanized ةـ in contact with another consonant from a roman digraph representing a single Arabic consonant, a single prime ' is placed between the two distinct letters, e.g., *ad 'ham* = أَدْهَم, *akramat 'hā* = أَكْرَمَتْهَا.
